## Plastic Free Campaign - Gopanhalli - 30-09-2019

As a move towards a low-polluting, sustainable society, recycling, reusing and proper management of plastics has become a crucial issue that needs focus. Taking the motive of UBA into account, “**Plastic Free Campaign**” was organized by our institution on 30-09-2019, in the adopted village Gopanhalli.

About 100 students from various streams of engineering volunteered along with 3 faculty members namely Dr. A. Geetha Kiran (UBA Coordinator), Mr. H. S. Chandrashekar (Assistant Professor, Dept. of IS & Engineering) and Mrs. Mohana Lakshmi J. (Assistant Professor, Department of EEE).
